

Separate terms and conditions for participation in the "Building-Greening Award 2020" (BuGG-Award 2020)

During the World Congress of Building Greening from 16 to 18 June 2020 in Berlin the „Building Greening Award 2020“ (BuGG-Award 2020) is assigned to three categories “roof greening”, “façade greening” and “interior greening”.

It is a prize for special projects which stand out above all in the following criteria: architecture, building physics, biodiversity/species protection, quality of the environment, rain water management.

The submission can be made by companies, cities or single persons.

Registration and processing

The registration has to be made in German or English at www.bugg-congress2020.com via a form until 31 March 2020. In addition to the project description, three photos of sufficient quality must be submitted. An international committee will review the submitted applications and it will give feedback to the participants until 20 April 2020.

The respective winners of the categories are invited to the congress as guests of honor. They will receive the award when the results are announced at the 16 or 17 June 2020.

The three best placed of each category will be published in the conference transcript.

For the publication in the congress transcript the three best placed must submit an abstract of the application to the organizer in German and English until 30 April 2020.

They will be informed of the details on 20 April, 2020 at the latest.

Abstracts submitted later can no longer be taken into account in the conference transcript. No right to withdraw or claim to compensation arises from this.

The condition for the participation in the awards is the complete specification of the requested data, the submission of photos in adequate quality to print and the right to publish the images with a reference to the source.

Maximum three applications can be submitted per company, country/city/municipality, association or person.

General terms and conditions

All bookings are binding. Amendments and cancellations must be made in writing and must be sent to the body stated on the order form. Verbal agreements are not binding insofar as they have not been confirmed in writing by the organizer.

Bank fees for chargebacks are borne by the participant in the award.

If the conference cannot be held or cannot be held in the offered and booked form for reasons that are not attributable to the organizer or the performing agency (e.g. natural disaster, strike or force majeure), there is neither a claim to a refund of the fee for applicant for the award or the congress nor to compensation for other damages or financial losses.

We indicate that the organizer is only liable for claims for physical injury due to intent or negligence and for material damage due to intent or gross negligence of the organizer. No further claims can be made. The organizer is not liable for the loss or theft of any items and motor vehicles brought to the event, except in the event of intent or grossly negligent causation.

No guarantee is made for program changes and timing alterations for events. The organizer reserves the right to reschedule or relocate events or parts thereof (seminars etc.). This also includes the cancellation of individual items in the program. This does not give applicants for the award the right to

withdraw. No compensation claims may be made for this. The organizer commits to notify the applicant for the award of any changes as soon as he becomes aware of them.

The organizer is also not liable for the attendance of announced speakers. In the event of cancellation, the participant does not have the right to compensation claims of any kind. The organizer will endeavor to resolve the situation with a suitable replacement. The current status of the speakers can be seen published online up to one week before the start of the event. Online amendments after this are no longer possible for technical reasons. What's more, there is no right to compensation for defective, missing or incomplete publications in printed materials or on the congress website.
